

HISTORY

Hillcrest, a quiet neighborhood Southeast of the Anacostia River, was once home to the Nacotchtank tribe. It's suburban charm, coupled with challenges African Americans faced integrating into upscale American neighborhoods in the mid-20th century is what attracted Washington's black elite to call it home, coining it the "Silver Coast". Now home to over 9,000 residents, most of whom are civic-minded and very fond of the neighborhood, Hillcrest boasts of its lush, green, manicured lawns, scenic rolling-hills and large brick colonials, tudors, ramblers- earning itself the tag "DC's best-kept secret."

Hillcrest's high altitude, which is 300 degrees above sea level, brings in an effervescence of pure air and desired temperatures five to ten degrees cooler than the rest of the city- which is particularly appreciated on hot, summer days. It's steep elevation in certain areas gives one a glance at breathtaking views of the Washington Capitol and Monuments, which are just a few of the wonderful sights this city has to offer.

Within just miles of popular tourist attractions, such as the Smithsonian Art Museum and the historical home of renown abolitionist Frederick Douglass, Hillcrest is a great destination for those looking to get away from the usual.
